GENERAL INFORMATION

Ecology Camp 2011 will be held at Camp Pupukea. It's been five years since we were here and the camp ground owned and operated by the Boy Scouts of America Aloha Council is one of our favorites. There are shower and restroom facilities available at the campsite. A large kitchen/cafeteria area will be used to cook food for all camp participants. Camping will be done in tents and each school is responsible for providing its own tents, lanterns, and other camping equipment.

1. **Registration Fee: \$45.00 per person.** Registration fee covers cost of food, lodging, and T-shirt. **Fees due by January 31, 2011.**
2. All participants must bring a brown bag lunch/bento for the first day.
3. Label all belongings.

Feminine hygiene
Grooming equipment
Sunglasses
Spare glasses/contacts (optional)

EQUIPMENT:

Sleeping bag
Day pack
Personal first aid kit
Signaling device (whistle)
Compass (optional)
Clothesline w/ pins (optional)
Air mattress or pad

Work gloves (**A MUST!**)
Two canteens or water bottles
Flashlight w/ extra batteries
Notebook and pen or pencil
Plastic bag for wet clothes, etc.
Mess kit w/ non-disposable eating utensils (plate, cup, fork, spoon, knife)

RECREATION:

Games, cards, musical instruments, sports equipment
NO electronic equipment

OTHER OPTIONAL ITEMS:

Binoculars, camera, extra film, batteries
Money for souvenirs, etc.
