IMPORTANT REGISTRATION REMINDERS:

1. **Each student** must complete and turn in the forms marked with a ▶ – TOTAL OF SEVEN (7) FORMS.
2. **All adults (club advisers, kōkua and chaperones)** must turn in forms highlighted in yellow - TOTAL OF FIVE (5) FORMS.
3. **Club advisers** must turn in the forms highlighted in yellow PLUS the TWO (2) FORMS highlighted in blue (Sign in Waiver and Registration List).
4. Deadline for all registration forms is **MARCH 30. NO REFUNDS AFTER THIS DATE. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
5. Send in your form to me c/o Hawai'i Nature Center, 2131 Makiki Heights Drive, Honolulu, HI 96822.
6. Make your check payable to "High School Hikers" and turn your payment in to Treasurer Bob Keane at the April HSH meeting.
7. Distribute materials to your students as soon as possible. Consider having a "Parents Night" to answer any questions they may have.
8. Be sure to receive your school's approval, complete all required school permission forms, and consider purchasing student insurance for any uninsured participants.
9. Camp site space is limited so each club will be allotted TEN (10) student slots. Others will be placed on a waiting list. I will inform you of space availability after forms from other clubs have been received.
10. Please make sure that all students attending Ecology Camp are fully aware about the camping conditions. They must also agree to participate in all the activities and service project and must provide their own equipment as listed on the general information flier.
